LOCAL LEGISLATION



TEMPORARY LAKE BALATON PERMITS NEEDED FOR ALL SUPPORT BOATS

Lake Balaton is a natural preservation area and the use of powerboats is strictly regulated by Hungarian law.

Only boats with proper permits, issued by the Hungarian authority may be used as support boats for the event.

Failure to obtain these permits may result in prosecution by the local authorities.

DEADLINE: JULY 8, 2022

AFTER THE DEADLINE, OA AND 1420CLASS WILL NOT TAKE RESPONSIBILITY FOR MISSING PERMITS, OR DIFFICULTIES IN OBTAINING THE PERMITS FROM THE LAKE AUTHORITY.

HOW TO REGISTER A SUPPORT BOAT FOR THE EVENT IN ORDER TO OBTAIN A PERMIT:

The support boat shall be registered by July 8, 2022 by sending the Support Boat Application Form and the copy of the boat certificate (if any) to:

- Balatoni YC will submit the relevant application to the Hungarian Authorities to obtain the permit for the registered team/support boat.
- Balatoni YC will send the copy of the permit issued by the Hungarian Authority to the registered team leader/coach by e-mail. The original (which shall be carried on the support boat during the event) will be given to the team leader during on-site registraion.

USEFUL INFORMATION



RULES & RECOMMENDATIONS

- The registered support boats can only be used for training, racing and rescue purposes, other use is strictly prohibited by law.
- The registered driver(s) of a support boat will be responsible for the control of the boat at all times and will be held responsible for any inappropriate behaviour or dangerous actions, or actions affecting the fairness or safety of competition.
- A support boat may support no more than ten boats entered.
- Each support boat is strongly recommended to carry a VHF radio on board.
- Each support boat driver and each crew member on board shall wear a
 personal flotation device at all times while they are afloat with the engine of
 their support boat running.
- It is strongly recommended that the kill cord is used at all times when the engine is running.
- The use of drones by support boats is prohibited.
